The trash pickup and recycle policy for Steeleville residents is as follows:

- ❖ Regular trash pickup is on Mondays and Tuesdays
- ❖ All curbside recycling is picked up on Wednesdays
- ❖ Village employees will pick up DRY PAPER (office waste, newspapers, books, magazines, cardboard boxes must be broken down) PLASTIC (only #1 & #2 grade plastics, soda, water, detergent bottles and milk jugs) and all types of METAL CANS (rinse with water). Place items in clear trash bags (not necessary to separate), securely tied, and place where your trash totes are normally placed between 6:00 p.m. Tuesday and 5:00 a.m. Wednesday.
- ❖ Yard waste must be placed in your own trash bags, tied securely, and will be picked up weekly starting on Mondays. You must call village hall at 618-965-3134 ext. 31 before 10:00 a.m. on Mondays to schedule yard waste pickup.
- ❖ Large items and electronics will be picked up on the first Thursday of each month. You must call village hall at 618-965-3134 ext. 31 to schedule a large item pickup.
- ❖ Electronics can be taken to the designated area at the maintenance building on Westwood Drive.
- ❖ Schedules can change due to holidays or emergency situations. Residents will be notified through our CTY message system.

We encourage our residents to take full advantage of this recycling program. Together we can keep our community clean and help protect our environment.

NEW STEELEVILLE RECYCLING GUIDELINES

Below are guidelines for the Village of Steeleville recycling program. These guidelines must be followed if the Village is to continue our curbside recycling program. Please pay close attention to the guidelines. Not following these instructions may result in the Village losing its ability to maintain the recycle program.

All recyclable items must be in a clear plastic bag beginning October 1. Clear plastic bags are available for purchase locally at Steeleville Marketplace or from online retailers.

Non-clear bags will not be picked up for recycling after October 1.
